Created as a joint initiative between the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the General Services Administration (GSA), the Fitwel Viral Response Module builds upon and operationalizes the global scientific evidence highlighted in Fitwel's [Research to Action](#) resource series, which creates data-driven strategies that mitigate viral transmission, build trust and create healthy environments for all occupants.

The Criteria

- **Enhanced Indoor Environments:** Indoor air quality, testing, monitoring, cleaning, green purchasing policies, etc.
- **Encourage Behavioral Change:** Hand hygiene, surface hygiene, health promotional signage, PPE guidelines, etc.
- **Build Occupant Trust:** Contagious Disease Outbreak Preparedness Plan, Communication plans, Paid Sick Leave, etc.
